What is Mercy Multiplied?

Mercy Multiplied is a nonprofit Christian organization that helps young women break free from life-controlling issues, including eating disorders, self-harm, drug and alcohol addictions, unplanned pregnancy, depression, sexual abuse, and sex trafficking. Our residential program is voluntary, biblically based, and completely free of charge to young women ages 13-28. Our goal is to help residents permanently stop destructive cycles, discover purpose for their lives, and become productive and thriving individuals. Our outreach programs and resources are based on the same biblically based, life-transforming principles used by Mercy homes.

Mercy Multiplied exists to provide opportunities and resources for all to experience God's unconditional love, forgiveness, and life-transforming power.

2017 Accomplishments

1. We expanded our counselor education to address the increasing severity of issues young women are facing, including an intensive training on complex trauma and subsequent best-practice trainings and case consultations.
2. We launched *Keys to Freedom*, a companion study to my book *Ditch the Baggage*. Men and women from across the world are reporting life-changing results from this dig-deeper application of the 7 keys to freedom we've seen transform lives for 35 years!
3. Our Outreach Department presented 4 MPower Workshops, 3 MPower Nights, and 1 Freedom Experience, equipping hundreds with tools to overcome destructive life patterns and more effectively reach the hurting.

2018 Goals

1. Reach and serve more hurting young women through increased awareness initiatives and a more streamlined application process to include higher levels of engagement
2. Expand outreach efforts by partnering with churches to equip and resource leaders for more effective ministry to the hurting and struggling in their communities
3. Enhance current Mercy homes through capital improvements, which maintains Mercy's standard of excellence and communicates Christ's love to residents
4. Continue to grow momentum and execute further developmental steps toward ground breaking of Mercy's Florida home

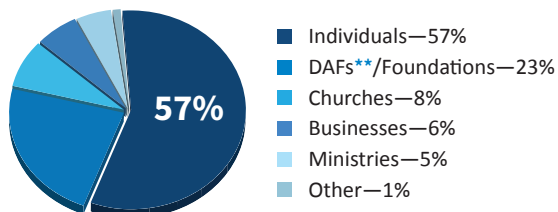

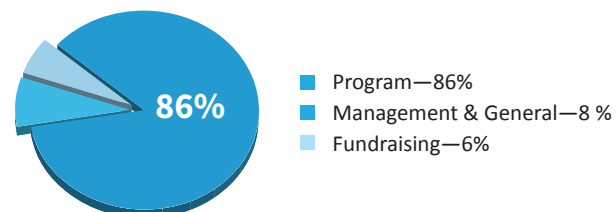
