### What is Mercy Multiplied?

Mercy Multiplied equips all people to live free and stay free through Jesus Christ. Mercy offers:

- **A free-of-charge residential counseling program** that helps young women ages 13-32 break free from life-controlling issues and situations
- **Outreach services** that train and resource Christian leaders and helpers to effectively minister to men and women who are struggling

### Mission Statement

Mercy Multiplied exists to provide opportunities and resources for all to experience God's unconditional love, forgiveness, and life-transforming power.

### 2019 Accomplishments

1. Mercy Multiplied continued to provide life-changing programs for young women in need. Our Intake Department fielded 13,105 contacts (phone calls, emails, texts) and processed more than 1,330 applications.
2. To date, Outreach services have trained over 1,500 pastors and leaders through our MPower Workshops and our *Keys to Freedom* study. *Keys to Freedom* has now been translated into Dutch, German, and Danish and we are working on a Spanish translation. Over 20,000 people around the world have been through the study.
3. In September, we celebrated the 10-year anniversary of our Sacramento home and all of the young women who have walked through the doors since opening in 2009.
4. We completed \$600,000 in capital improvements to existing properties, debt free.

### 2020 Goals

1. Serve more hurting young women through increased awareness initiatives and expand our reach through the development of strategic partnerships
2. Expand outreach efforts by partnering with churches, non-profits, and social good organizations to equip and resource leaders for more effective ministry to the hurting and struggling in their communities
3. Enhance current Mercy homes through capital improvements, which maintains Mercy's standard of excellence and communicates Christ's love to residents

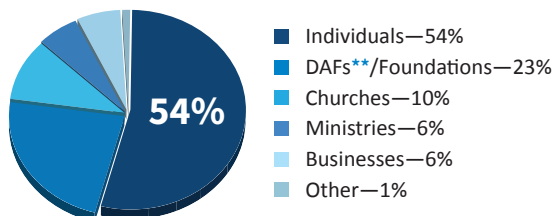

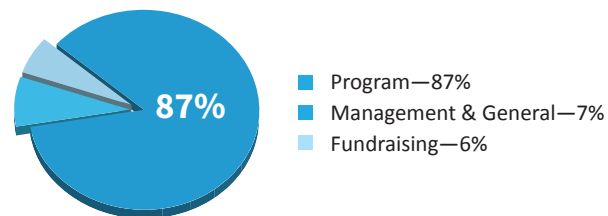
