Mission Statement

Mercy Multiplied exists to provide opportunities and resources for all to experience God's unconditional love, forgiveness, and life-transforming power.

What We Do

Mercy has a residential program for women ages 13–32 and offers outpatient services to women aged 13 or older. These services are voluntary, biblically-based, and free-of-charge. Through our Outreach Services we provide multiple resources online and onsite designed to equip men and women of all ages to live free and stay free in Jesus Christ.

2020 Accomplishments

1. With some adjustments due to COVID-19, Mercy's residential program remained open and operational throughout the entire year. Mercy's Intake Department fielded 11,367 contacts (phone calls, emails, texts) and processed more than 1,271 applications.
2. The Mercy Center for Wellness and Counseling prototype was launched in West Monroe, LA, offering free-of-charge outpatient care to women aged 13 and older and allowing us to serve three times as many people as before in that location.
3. Our MPower Workshop was shifted to a virtual platform due to COVID-19 and it our largest MPower Workshop to date with participants from 27 states and international attendees from Canada, India, Dominican Republic, and Costa Rica!
4. *Keys to Freedom* has been translated into five languages, including Spanish, Dutch, German, Swedish, and Danish with thousands of studies having been distributed to date. We know of at least 21 countries where *Keys to Freedom* groups are being held, including: Australia, Austria, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, Dominican Republic, Faroe Islands, Germany, Guatemala, Ireland, Isle of Man, Italy, Mexico, Netherlands, Rwanda, South Africa, Sweden, Uganda, United Kingdom, United States, and Zambia.

2021 Goals

1. Expand our reach through non-residential counseling through the Mercy Center for Wellness and Counseling
2. Increase our Outreach Services by producing additional online trainings
3. Enhance the residential program through added resources for parents and support persons as well as increased awareness initiatives

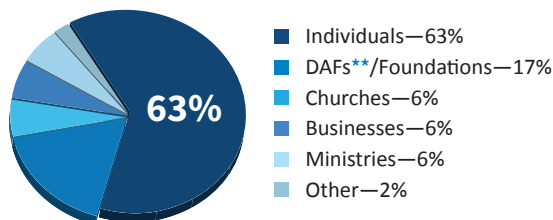

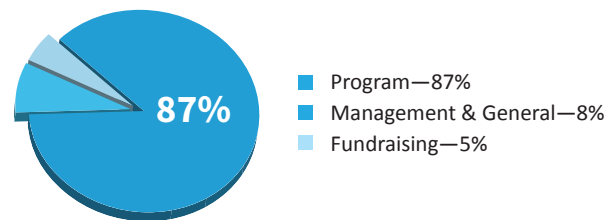
