Mission Statement

Mercy Multiplied exists to provide opportunities and resources for all to experience God's unconditional love, forgiveness, and life-transforming power.

What We Do

Mercy has a Residential Program for women ages 13–32 and Outpatient Programs for men (Louisiana only) and women ages 13 or older. These services are voluntary, biblically-based, and free-of-charge. Through our Outreach Services we provide multiple resources online and onsite designed to equip men and women of all ages to live free and stay free in Jesus Christ.

2024 Accomplishments

- At our Centers for Wellness and Counseling, in Monroe, LA and St. Louis, MO we provided free counseling for 191 women and 37 men in 2024.
- 194 people went through our MPower training this year, either in-person or online. (Over 3,000 people have experienced MPower training over the past 9 years, including leaders from more than 500 churches and ministries.)
- 181 women participated in the new 5-day Keys to Freedom Retreat on our St. Louis campus. This included 13 women who took part in a new retreat curated specifically for pastors and ministry leaders.
- Mercy created a new resource for parents of struggling teenagers in partnership with Axis, an organization with an engaged audience of almost 375,000 adults who collectively influence more than 5 million young people. The Guide for Parents of Struggling Teens is now available on the Mercy website and the Axis site.
- 65 young women participated in our Residential Counseling Program this year. Ten residents chose to follow Christ in baptism. Five of these women professed their faith in Jesus for the first time.

- Residential Counseling Program by creating and implementing additional life skills trainings and resources to equip young women for success in their future.
- Increase Outreach Services through varied offerings of the Keys to Freedom Retreat in St. Louis, including a Pilot of a Men's Retreat.
- Enhance the application process for Mercy services by developing a streamlined online application with an improved website and user-friendly app that increases ease of access, simplifies navigation, and ensures users can quickly and easily find the information they need.
- Develop and pilot a segment of the envisioned future Keys to Freedom Youth curriculum, focusing on testing and refining its content and delivery to ensure alignment with audience needs.

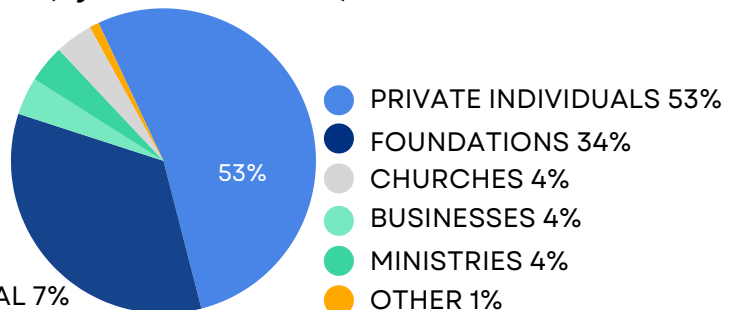
